

FREE Sprinkler Inspection Program

Get the right amount of water in the right place at the right time

What is an Irrigation Inspection? An Irrigation Inspection is a series of tests performed on your home's sprinkler system that determine its efficiency. The tests will check the application rate, uniformity of application and pressure of your system, as well as the soil type and root depth of your grass to determine how the efficiency of the system can be improved upon and to develop the most appropriate watering schedule for the landscape. A Visual Inspection of the system will also be conducted to pinpoint any flaws or repairs that need to be addressed.

How much does it cost? NOTHING! It is FREE! The program is funded by grants as well as the City of Golden.

How long does it take? The entire process will take about two hours for residential sites. (Commercial or Home Owner Association sites may take longer.)

When can I get an inspection? The service is available from the beginning of June until the beginning of August.

Who is eligible? If you receive water from the City of Golden and have an underground irrigation system that waters turf, **YOU ARE ELIGIBLE.** Commercial and HOA sites may also be eligible to participate, and should call for more information.

Why get an irrigation audit?

- Save money on your water bill
- Improve the appearance of your landscape
- Increase efficiency of water usage
- Receive a customized watering schedule
- Maximize the life-span and effectiveness of your sprinkler system
- Help conserve one of Colorado's most precious resources
